

Dalton Utilities 2020 Hunt Regulations

1. Hunters are responsible to insure that they have the proper license; all state laws and license are enforced and required. Photo ID may be required.
2. Only hunters with permits will be allowed on site. Please do not bring other family members or friends. They will be denied access to the property.
3. Only deer may be harvested. No baiting will be allowed.
4. Hunters must use personal state issued deer tags.
5. All hunters **MUST** check in on the mandatory check-in day stated on your acceptance letter. Any hunter that does not check in between 12:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. on the mandatory check-in day **will not** be allowed to hunt.
6. **Hunters must check in and out at the designated area.** Hunters will be allowed to use personal vehicles on designated roads only. *****No all terrain vehicles (ATV's)***** (except on disabled hunts).
7. Hunt areas will be assigned by lottery.
8. **Pre-hunt scouting and hunting is allowed only on specified dates.**
9. Portable tree stands only, no nails or spikes in trees. Stands may be hung during pre-hunt scouting and left until the end of the hunt. Stands may not be hung on power poles or electrical transmission line structures.
10. Please do not use flagging tape or other locating devices.
11. **All hunters are required to wear 500 sq. inches of orange above the waist at all times.**
12. All deer must be brought to the check-in station **before** field dressing and for recording of age, sex, and weight.
13. When tracking crippled deer, please be considerate of other hunters. If you are unsure of other hunters' locations, check with personnel at check-in station.
14. Any lost and found or illegal hunting equipment will be turned over to the DNR.
15. Dalton Utilities is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged property.
16. **No camping** will be allowed on Dalton Utilities' property.

DIRECTIONS TO DALTON UTILITIES LAND APPLICATION SYSTEM (LAS) PROPERTY

From Atlanta:

Take I-75 North to Exit 317, Hwy. 225 North
Go North on Hwy. 225 approximately 10 miles
The entrance to the LAS property is on the left
Look for the Dalton Utilities sign about 4 miles
Past the intersection of Hwy. 136
The closest address to the gate is 8179 Hwy. 225 South

From Chattanooga:

Take I-75 South to Exit 333, Hwy. 52 (Walnut Ave.)
Turn East on Hwy. 52, towards Chatsworth
Turn right onto Hwy. 225 South
Continue South to the LAS property gate on right
The closest address to the gate is 8008 Hwy. 225 South
